West Toowong Bowls Club – Types of Membership

Ordinary Member (\$120 per annum)

These members have full bowling and voting rights and will normally be registered with Bowls Qld to play in Social, Club Championships and interclub competitions. Players who are members of two clubs will have to declare which club they will play for in certain District events. Members who do not play in competitions will not be registered with Bowls Qld

Associate Member (\$60 per annum)

Associates can play in club social competitions, certain club special events and non CoCC club championship events (triples, mixed pairs, open B singles). However, these members have no voting rights, are not eligible to hold any office in the club or nominate new members. They can use the bowling green facilities for non-competition activities (e.g., practice, rollups)

Junior Member (\$TBA per annum)

These members must be under 18 and are eligible to play in Club Championship and official interclub competitions. They have no voting rights, not eligible to hold any office in the club or nominate new members.

Social Members (\$5 for 2 years) – USE SEPARATE APPLICATION FORM

These members have full access to clubhouse but have no bowling or voting rights and cannot hold any office in the club. If social members wanted to play bowls, they would have to pay the Barefoot Bowling fee of \$10 per session.

Green Fees

Green fees for club and social competitions is usually \$15 on Wednesdays and Saturdays and includes snack food. For competition games played on Sundays the fee would be \$10 with no snack food.

Conduct of Members

Members must maintain a proper discipline and decorum and shall not conduct illegal gambling, bet on games, speak obscene or abusive language, or indulge in unseemly conduct. Where members breach this rule, the Management Committee has the power to demand and direct apologies, and, if necessary, suspend or expel the member.

Privacy Policy
